SlashNext Windows Intune Guide

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1 | INTRODUCTION

This document provides step-by-step instructions for adding the SlashNext Browser Protection Installer to Microsoft Intune to install Chrome, Firefox and Edge Chromium extensions to devices managed through Microsoft Intune.

2 | ADD SLASHNEXT INSTALLER AS MICROSOFT INTUNE CLIENT APP

Follow the below step-by-step guide to add SlashNext Browser Protection Installer for internal distribution.

1. Log in to the Microsoft Endpoint Manager Admin Portal using your admin account.

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3 | VERIFY INSTALLATION OF BROWSER EXTENSIONS ON USER'S MACHINE

Follow these steps to verify the installation of the browser extensions.

- 1. Sign-In to any managed machine and sync the Company Portal App.
- 2. Open Chrome, Firefox or Edge Chromium browser. SlashNext Browser Protection extension icon will appear on the right corner of the address bar and the Extension Activation Successful screen will appear.

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4 | SILENTLY INSTALL SLAHNEXT PHISHING PROTECTION MSI WITH INSTALL PARAMETERS

Optionally, you can enter any custom command-line argument that you want to apply to the MSI file when it runs.

To add command line parameter in Microsoft Intune, Add command line argument in **Step 7** on the app information page with **Device Context** settings selected in **App install context**.

4.1 | SWITCHES AND PARAMETERS

The following table lists all the switches and possible enrolment parameters you can enter into the command line and the respective description and values for each parameter.

Switches and Parameter	Description and Values of Parameters
/qn	Allow fully silent mode
INSTALLPARAM=Value	 Enter value chrome for installation of Chrome extension Enter value firefox for installation of Firefox extension Enter value edge for installation of Edge Chromium extension Enter value chrome, firefox for installation of Chrome and Firefox extensions Enter value chrome, edge for installation of Chrome and Edge Chromium extensions Enter value chrome, edge for installation of Chrome and Edge Chromium extensions Enter value firefox, edge for installation of Firefox and Edge Chromium extensions Enter value firefox, edge for installation of Firefox and Edge Chromium extensions Enter value chrome, firefox, edge for installation of Chrome, Firefox and Edge Chromium extensions

The following syntax is used in Microsoft Intune command line where value is added to install extension on specified browser.

/qn INSTALLPARAM=value

To install the Chrome extension, the following syntax is used:

/qn INSTALLPARAM=chrome

To install the extension to more than 1 supported browser, a comma-separated value is used. To install Chrome and Firefox extensions, the following syntax is used.

/qn INSTALLPARAM=chrome,firefox

INSTALLPARAM value can be <chrome/firefox/edge/chrome,firefox/chrome,edge/firefox,edge/chrome,firefox,edge> according to requirement. Initiating any one of these examples silently installs the product without prompting the user to select any of the acknowl-edgment buttons.

Note

- If INSTALLPARAM is not given all Chrome, Firefox and Edge Chromium extensions will get installed silently.
- Microsoft Intune allows command-line custom parameters only in Device context.
